

Tiffeny Milbrett, former OYSA, University of Portland, & U.S Women's National Team player to be the AGM Keynote Speaker.



Oregon Youth Soccer is proud to announce that Tiffeny Milbrett will be the Keynote Speaker at this year's AGM & Workshops on February 11th at the adidas Village in Portland.

Tiffeny started her soccer career playing for Oregon Youth Soccer's member club: Hillsboro Soccer Club. She attended Hillsboro High School from 1987 to 1990, where she graduated holding Oregon's state record for goals in a season with 54; and in a career with 131.

She then starred at the University of Portland from 1990 to 1995 where she was their all-time leader in goals with 103, and assists with 40.

Tiffeny saw her first action with the USA National team in 1991, and continued a storied 15 years with team USA. Her 100th goal came in Team USA's match against Ukraine in her hometown of Portland at Merlo Field. She won an Olympic gold medal in 1996 in Atlanta and a silver medal at the 2000 Olympics in Sydney. In 1999, she was the goal leader on the USA team that won the World Cup.

She most recently played for FC Gold Pride of Women's Professional Soccer during the 2009-2011 seasons, after playing for 5 other club teams in her career.

Tiffeny is now a full-time coach after retiring from playing in 2011 (after FC Gold Pride won the WPS championship). She currently coaches three U11 teams for MVLA soccer club in Mountain View, CA.
