

## OYSA PENALTY POINTS

Please refer to specific League rules for minimum game suspensions when a player is shown a red card and sent off during League play. Suspensions also apply to coaches.

Penalty points for all red and yellow cards are cumulative for the entire season, e.g. Winter League for individual members (players/coaches) as well as teams. \*Exception: Yellow card points issued for 'dissent' and 'unsporting conduct' during the Fall and Winter Leagues are cumulative for the individual only on a per league basis and do not affect total team points.

Yellow Card = 2 pts. (2 yellow cards issued to same person in one game count as 4 pts.)  
Red Card = 3 pts. (abusive, offensive, or insulting language and/or gestures)  
Red Card = 3 pts. (denying a goal scoring opportunity by hand or foul)  
Red Card = 4 pts. (2nd caution – person will only receive a maximum of 4 penalty points for 2 cautions in a single match)  
Red Card = 5 pts. (serious foul play/violent conduct/spitting)

Individual member sanctions for accumulated penalty points:

6 points = 1 game suspension  
9 points = 3 game suspension  
12 points = Suspension for remainder of the current league/tournament

**Red card suspensions not served during League play will carry over into Oregon State Cup and President's Cup games. Penalty point suspensions will not carry over into Oregon State Cup and President's Cup games; instead the suspension will be served in the next league.**

Team sanctions for accumulated penalty points:

10 points = Advisory letter to Club President and Team Coach.  
20 points = \$200 fine; coach placed on probation.  
30 points = \$1000 fine; Team placed on probation for the remainder of the seasonal year. Club shall provide Oregon Youth Soccer with a written description of corrective actions regarding accumulation issue within 7 days of receiving fine notice.  
35 points = Team suspended for the remainder of the seasonal year and all unplayed league and tournament games will be recorded as forfeits. Suspended teams are not permitted to enter any US Youth Soccer sanctioned tournaments/leagues and Oregon Youth Soccer will not approve any out of state travel.

- Be advised that coaches may be held responsible for the behavior and actions of everyone associated with their respective teams during league play.
- Clubs are reminded that they are responsible for the proper supervision of the teams they sponsor and any dues levied against their teams.
