



Age Breakdown for Oregon ODP

- Oregon ODP has five age group pools in the state.
- The ODP program is a calendar year program, which means, players born in a particular year, for example, players born in 1994 (Jan. 1-Dec. 31) are eligible to tryout for the 1994 ODP Pool.
- The only time Oregon ODP offers younger players the chance to “play up” in ODP is at the youngest age group.

1996 Pool-Players born Jan. 1, 1996-Dec. 31, 1996

1997 Pool-Players born Jan. 1, 1997-Dec. 31, 1997

*1998 Pool-Players born Jan. 1, 1998-Dec. 31, 1998

***Players born in 1999 will be allowed to tryout for the 1998 ODP Pool. If a player born in 1999 makes the 98’ team, they will be allowed to participate in every event during season except Regional Camp.**

Oregon ODP Junior Olympic Camp Program

-Oregon ODP does offer a Junior Olympic Program for players 1-2 years away from playing in Oregon ODP. This program consists of Regionalized Camps in your particular area. A list of camps and dates are included below on the ODP website. The Oregon ODP staff uses these camps to prepare players for the ODP level, and evaluate players for future teams.
