

HOW TO ASSEMBLE MEMBER PASSES

Once a team/member is properly registered, member passes will be produced by the OYSA Registration Department and sent to the club registrar.

- The Club Registrar or President will sign the back of the white Member Pass in the designated place.
- The Member Pass should then be sent to the parent, team contact or coach.
- A current approx 1x1 photo will need to be attached on the backside of the card in the designated place
- Separate the White Member Pass from the Blue Membership Card.
- OYSA does not require players to sign the card; however some tournaments do require player's signature. If you are traveling to tournaments we suggest you have player sign the member passes before they are laminated.
- The member passes must then be laminated. Once laminated, the member pass is a valid player card.
- Coaches are encouraged to punch a hole in each card and place cards on a ring or cord in roster order.
