Hasson and Abegg named Gatorade Players of the Year

Tracy Hasson and Marisa Abegg, two former Oregon ODP players, have been named Gatorade Players of the Year for the state of Oregon. Hasson (Lake Oswego High School) and Abegg (Lakeridge High School) are now in the running for the Gatorade athlete of the Year which will be presented at a luncheon July 14 in Hollywood, Calif.
